Meeting Minutes

November 12, 2007

1. Update from Chad and Russell on club additions, changes and issues since last meeting.
 - a. The Tennis Ladder is now ready. We should be hearing from Greg soon on the details. There will be a board with the current order listed and challenges will be used to “climb the ladder”. This is for Singles and Doubles.
 - b. Pepsi is our main drink brand.
 - c. The coolers have been replaced by our Pepsi Rep.
 - d. Russell is now at club full-time to supervise daily operations.
 - e. Cardio Tennis has started. The sessions are regularly full and seem to be a success.
 - f. Due to some comment e-mails may be limited to 1-2 a month. Updates will be on website and Forum.
 - g. Prince is the new lead product at the Proshop.
 - h. Proshop is currently being redone and restocked. Merchandise will be available at competitive prices for the convenience of the members. All members are encouraged to take advantage of this.
 - i. With the ball contract the club has plenty of balls available. Members and captains are encouraged to take advantage of this. The club gets new ball shipments, whether they are sold or not.
 - j. Men’s Round Robin’s are back to Mondays and will be earlier as schedules allow.
 - k. Water problems on courts 3 & 4 have been worked on and greatly improved.

2. New Business
 - a. Court No-Shows.

Court No-Shows continue to be a problem. The website shows the courts are full and sometimes very few courts are actually being used. The staff will be made aware of this again and will watch the situation as best as possible. When the reservation system is full Members are encouraged to call the club for any possible openings. Also, a court # will be added to the sign-in sheet for better tracking.
 - b. Court 7 & 8 Water Damage,

It has been noted that there is some new bubbling and damage on courts 7 & 8. The club will wait until league is over (combo) and possibly a couple of more weeks to see if any other spots come up. They will then be

repaired. The repair company charges 3 Full Days of work for the repairs, no matter how many patches have to be done.

c. Forming Teams in Spring

d. Anyone available to give a little help at Member-Member Tourney, please see Russell. Lots planned for the Tourney. This is a break-even event. The entry fee is being spent on prizes food and party.

e. Unsupervised Children

The biggest problem of damage at the club has been due to unsupervised children. We need to police the children when we are at the club. For the future we may need to consider Members bringing their own equipment for activities such as Ping Pong. The club will purchase new equipment and continue to monitor the damage.
